CardioMEMS™

Project Summary



Objectives

• This registry will act as a database of all CardioMEMS[™] device implantations in patients in the pediatric age range or with congenital heart disease. The aim is to determine feasibility and safety of device implantation in this patient population and to identify factors associated with peri-procedural success.

Inclusion

All patients who have a CardioMEMS™ device implantation (or attempted implantation) at an ACTION site.

- Q. If I previously entered my patient in the CardioMEMS™ REDCap, do I need to enter him/her again?
 - No. The previous CardioMEMS™ REDCap has been closed and all data have been merged into the current HF Registry. You do not need to enter the patient in both.
- Q. How do I enter a patient who received a CardioMEMS™ in the new ACTION HF Registry?
 - On the ACTION HF Registry REDCap, select "add new record". Then you will select the "Entry" form under "Enroll". On this form, you will be asked some very limited demographic/diagnosis information and then indicate which project you are enrolling your patient in. There is a place to select "CardioMEMS".
- Q. Do I have to participate in any other part of the ACTION HF Registry?
 - No. You do not have to participate in any other part of the ACTION HF Registry, though we encourage you to if your patient meets criteria for inclusion in any of the other ACTION HF projects
- Q. Do I have to obtain consent to enroll my patient for this CardioMEMS™ project?
 - Yes. Consent is required.
